- 5. **Warranties**. Subcontractor warrants that the Work will be performed in a workmanlike manner and in accordance with all applicable laws, codes, and regulations. Subcontractor further warrants that the Work will be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of [insert warranty period] from the completion of the Work.
- Insurance. Subcontractor shall maintain insurance coverage as required by law and as reasonably necessary to protect against claims arising out of or in connection with the Work.

- 8. **Termination**. Either party may terminate this Agreement for any reason upon [insert notice period] days' written notice to the other party.
- 9. **Assignment**. Subcontractor shall not assign or subcontract any of its obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of General Contractor.
- 10. **Entire Agreement**. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, and agreements, whether written or oral.

- 17. **Dispute Resolution**. Any disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be resolved through binding arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association.
