In exchange for the Employee's acceptance of the terms of this Agreement, the Employer will pay the Employee a severance payment in the amount of [Severance Amount in Dollars]. - 5. **Non-Disparagement**. The Employee agrees that he/she will not disparage the Employer, its employees, officers, or directors, either orally or in writing, to any third party.
- 6. **Confidentiality**. The Employee agrees that he/she will not disclose any confidential information of the Employer, including but not limited to trade secrets, business plans, financial information, or customer lists, to any third party.
- 7. Release of Claims. The Employee agrees to release the Employer and its employees, officers, and directors from any and all claims, causes of action, or other liabilities arising out of or related to the Employee's employment with the Employer or the termination of that employment.



8.	Cooperation. The Employee agrees to cooperate with the Employer in connection with
	any legal, regulatory, or other proceedings involving the Employer or its business, to the
	extent that such cooperation does not conflict with the Employee's other obligations.

- Non-Competition. The Employee agrees that for a period of ______ months following
 the Separation Date, he/she will not directly or indirectly engage in any business that

- 11. **Governing Language**. The parties acknowledge that this Agreement has been drafted in the English language, which shall be the controlling language of this Agreement. If any translation of this Agreement is necessary, the parties agree that the English language version shall control and take precedence over any other translations.
- 12. **Attorneys' Fees**. In the event of any dispute arising out of or related to this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorneys' fees and costs incurred in connection with such dispute.
- 13. **Severability**. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 14. **No Admission of Liability.** This Agreement shall not be construed as an admission of liability by the Employer, its employees, officers, or directors, and the Employer specifically denies any liability or wrongdoing in connection with the Employee's employment or the termination of that employment.
- 15. **No Oral Modification**. This Agreement may not be amended, modified, or supplemented except in writing signed by both parties.
- 16. Binding Effect. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns.
- 17. **Notices**. Any notice, request, demand, or other communication required or permitted by this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been given when received if delivered personally or by overnight delivery, or when sent by email with confirmation of receipt.
- 18. **Governing Law**. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the state of _____



- 19. **Entire Agreement**. This Agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior negotiations, understandings, and agreements between the parties.
- 20. **Amendment**. This Agreement may only be amended by written agreement executed by both parties.
