DEFAULTS:

If Tenant fails to perform or fulfill any obligation under this Lease, Tenant shall be in default. Tenant shall have seven (7) days from the date of Landlord's notice of default to cure the default, subject to any statute, ordinance, or law to the contrary. In the event Tenant does not cure a default, Landlord may at Landlord's option;

- (a) cure such default and the cost of such action may be added to Tenant's financial obligations under this lease; or
- (b) declare Tenant in default of the Lease. In the event of default, Landlord may also, as permitted by law, re-enter the Premises and re-take possession of the Premises.

If the Premises are re-let, Landlord may hold Tenant liable for any difference between the rent that would have been payable under this Lease during the remainder of the unexpired term and any subsequent rent paid by any successive Tenant. If Landlord is unable to relet the Premises during any remaining term of this Lease, after default by Tenant, Landlord may at its option hold Tenant liable for the balance of unpaid rent under this Lease. Tenants, guests, or invitees who fail to comply with any term of this Lease will be terminated with appropriate notice to Tenants and procedures as required by law.

POSSESSION AND SURRENDER OF PREMISES:

Upon the commencement of the Lease Term, the Tenant has the right to take possession of the Premises. Tenant shall peacefully surrender the Premises to Landlord or Landlord's agent at the end of the Lease, in the same condition as at the beginning of the Lease, with a reasonable allowance for wear and tear.

ASSIGNMENT AND SUBLEASE:

There shall be no assignment or subletting of any interest in this Lease by the Tenant without the prior written consent of the Landlord.

DANGEROUS MATERIALS:

The Tenant shall not keep or have on or around the Premises any dangerous, flammable, or explosive item that might unnecessarily increase the risk of fire or explosion on or around the Premises and that is deemed hazardous by any reasonable insurance company.

ALTERATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS:

Tenant agrees not to alter or improve the Premises without Landlord's prior written consent. A change, improvement, or addition made to or built around the Premises, except fixtures and personal property that may be removed without damaging the Premises, shall become the property of the Landlord at the expiration of the Lease and remain so, unless otherwise agreed in writing.

MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR:

Tenant will, at Tenant's sole expense, keep and maintain the Premises in good, clean and sanitary condition and repair during the term of this Lease and any renewal thereof.

SECURITY AND RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSS:

It is understood that Landlord is not responsible for providing any security alarms or other security at the Premises. Tenant's vehicle or other possessions will occupy the parking space entirely at the risk of the Tenant. Tenant releases Landlord from any loss, damage, claim or injury resulting from any casualty.

SEVERABILITY:

If any part or parts of this Lease shall be held unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of this Lease shall continue in full force and effect. If any provision of this Lease is deemed invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, and if limiting such provision would make the provision valid, then such provision shall be deemed to be construed as so limited.

BINDING EFFECT:

In the Lease, the covenants and conditions are binding upon the parties and their heirs, legal representatives, successors, and permitted assignees.

GOVERNING LAW:
