\Box - Mailboxes. A mailbox will be available to the tenant during the term of this Agreement for $_/$ month.
 □ - Printing & Copying. Documents requested by the Tenant for printing or copying shall be charged at \$/black & white and \$/color.
\Box - Workstations. All workstations, meeting areas, and call areas located within the Premises are available on a first-come, first-served basis during regular business hours.

Tenants are entitled to privileges and uses in common with other tenants on the premises. Tenants understand their lease agreements with landlords determine their use of the premises. The term "co-working" or any other term in this Agreement does not imply that the rights of each tenant are equal.

BUSINESS HOURS.

OPERATING STANDARDS.

As part of this Agreement, and all other co-working space agreements on the Premises, the Tenant and the tenants agree to the following standards to conduct:

Individuals or businesses will not conduct any activity within the Premises that, in the opinion of the Landlord, creates excessive traffic or interferes with the co-working experience of other tenants;

It is prohibited for an individual or business to advertise or display identifying signs or notices on any part of the Premises without the Landlord's express written consent;



Any common areas of the Premises shall be kept clean after use by tenants. Among these are conference rooms, call areas, coffee and snack areas, visual equipment, and any other areas used by other tenants;

It is prohibited for tenants to smoke anywhere on the premises; and

The tenants are expected to conduct themselves in a courteous manner towards all other tenants.

To ensure that tenants are in a good co-working environment, the landlord reserves the right to make other reasonable rules and regulations from time to time.

WAIVER.

Under this Agreement, the Landlord shall not be liable for any interruptions or errors in the performance of the services. The Tenant waives any and all claims against the Landlord arising from the disruption of services, specifically, any telecommunication utilities on the Premises. The Landlord is also not liable for any loss, damage, expense, or injury caused to persons or Tenant's property as a result of mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, errors, or defects in any transmissions provided in the course of providing telecommunications services, nor any claim for business interruption or consequential damages.

Both Parties hereby agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless from and against any and all claims, damages, injury, loss, and expenses to or of any portion or property in the event their agents, employees, invitees, and/or licensees commit any act of negligence while on the Premises.

DEFAULT.

If the Tenant violates any portion of this Agreement, they will be considered in default. Upon discovery of a violation of this Agreement by the Tenant, the Landlord shall notify the Tenant that the violation must be corrected within forty-eight (48) hours or this Agreement shall immediately terminate.

NOTICES.

All notices shall be sent to the mailing address located in Section I of this Agreement.

TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE.

Time is of the essence in relation to the Tenant's performance and all covenants, terms and provisions of this Agreement.



SEVERABILITY.

In the event that any provision or application of this Agreement is invalid or unenforceable for any reason or to any extent, the remainder of this Agreement and its application to other individuals, entities, or circumstances shall not be affected, but will instead be enforced to the fullest extent legally possible.

INDEMNIFICATION.

If any damage or injury occurs on the Premises, or any part thereof, or in the common areas thereof, the Landlord shall not be responsible to the Tenant or to any other person, or any property. Unless the Landlord's negligence has been the sole cause of the claims or damages, the Tenant agrees to hold the Landlord harmless. Purchasing renter's insurance is recommended at the tenant's expense.
